Why do we speak of the love of God? Because the will of God is God's inscrutable love for us! ... The will of God is not a "thing" or a rule or an object to attain. It is not like getting a degree or finding the right spouse. We cannot find the will of God as if finding an object; nor can we follow the will of God as if following a method or a plan of life. We cannot understand God's love in the same way we understand a math problem or a story. The will of God is the perfect, simple, absolute love of God and the desire of God for his creatures.

To seek the will of God is to remain open to the many ways God expresses his love for us, through our neighbors, our family members, our community, or the beauty of creation. God's love is mystery; it is incomprehensible, ineffable, invisible, indescribable, yet this love is the reason for our lives and for the life of this universe. Without the love of God we would not exist.

God's will is God's love for us and we must be ready to encounter that love, accept it, and respond to it in love. The meaning of our lives can only be found in the love of God. For deep in the love of God lies our happiness, our peace, our hope, and our fullness of life.


Love flows on
